## SIGN REGULATIONS

2008

- EACH SIGN SHALL NOT EXCEED SIX SQUARE FEET IN TOTAL AREA.
- ALL SUCH SIGNS SHALL BE ERECTED NO SOONER THAN 30 DAYS PRIOR TO THE ELECTION AND REMOVED WITHIN 7 DAYS AFTER THE ELECTION FOR WHICH THEY WERE MADE.
- THE PARTY RESPONSIBLE FOR ERECTING THE SIGN SHALL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR VIOLATIONS.
- NO SIGNS SHALL BE PLACED IN A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY OR IN A LOCATION OR MANNER WHICH WOULD ENDANGER PUBLIC SAFETY (E.G., SIGNS MUST BE SAFELY ANCHORED OR INSTALLED USING APPROPRIATE MATERIALS AND IN A MANNER THAT DOES NOT OBSTRUCT THE VIEW OF SAFE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES OR PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC).
- PERSONS PLACING OFF PREMISE TEMPORARY SIGNS SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING PERMISSION FROM THE PROPERTY OWNER TO POST THE SIGNS. PROPERTY OWNERS MAY REMOVE ANY OFF-PREMISE TEMPORARY SIGN FROM THEIR PROPERTY AT THEIR DISCRETION.
- SIGNS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY MUST BE PLACED AT LEAST 12 FEET FROM EDGE OF PAVEMENT.
